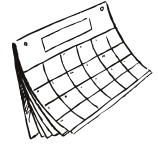
PAINTING PARTY! AND YOU'RE INVITED!



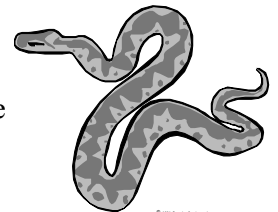
